Rules Revisions

1. The goalkeeper's top is part of the uniform and should be dealt with as a uniform violation not an equipment violation.
2. Officials can hold for advantage after time expires, to award a penalty corner or penalty stroke.
3. Stick interference occurs when a player hits, holds, hooks, slashes or strikes an opponent's stick.
4. It is a penalty when a team requests a second time-out, and the official stops play.
5. A standardized procedure has been established to start a penalty corner with an official's whistle.

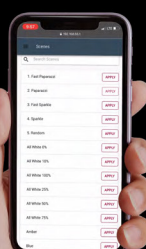
