## Points of **Emphasis**

- 1. Use of the Green Card/Delay of Game
- 2. Managing Safe Play in the 8-Meter Arc
- 3. Offensive Fouls Inside the Critical Scoring Area



## Rules Revisions

- The clock will stop on the official's whistle after each goal and when a foul is called in the critical scoring area during the last minute of each quarter.
- When one player draws illegally, the free position will be from the spot of the ball; and when both players draw illegally, a re-draw will be at the center line.
- The indirect free position for a minor foul by a defense player occurring in the 12-meter fan has been eliminated, and the player who is fouled may shoot from a free position on the 12-meter fan.
- For a pick to be legal, the crosse must be in a vertical position (between 10 o'clock and 2 o'clock) and the player's body shall be in a vertical plane with a stance not wider than shoulder width.
- The definition of a major foul for Illegal Stick Contact now includes contact with the opponent's crosse when a player's crosse is held in a horizontal position.
- The definition of a Rough/Dangerous Check now includes checking an opponent's hand.
